HOME READING TIPS

We will be continuing with Wilbur the Bookworm into November. Please remember that you can fill in one circle per day, regardless of how many books you read in that day. Reading together is the most important homework you can do with your child. It helps your child with print and phonological awareness, and oral language. The ability to read and write is incorporated into every subject area. Please consider the following tips:

1. Listening is an acquired skill that must be taught and cultivated gradually.
2. Stop before the end of the story to predict what will happen next
3. After reading, have your child retell the story in their own words
4. Find letters or words they know in the print
5. Read the pictures - tell the story by reading pictures, not words
