# Register for Kindergarten

Do you know a child who will start Kindergarten in fall 2016? Registration for the 2016-2017 school year is underway. Children are eligible to enroll in Kindergarten for the upcoming school year if they will be five years old on or before December 31, 2016.

### **Boundary Exemption Request Process for 2016-2017**

Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) reminds families that the boundary exemption request process will take place **February 1**<sup>st</sup> **to March 13, 2016** for students who want to attend a non-designated school in the 2016-2017 school year. During this time, interested families must fill out and submit the *Boundary Exemption Request Form* (posted on the EIPS website starting February 1<sup>st</sup>) to the requested school.

As of the April 14<sup>th</sup> deadline, if the boundary exemption request demand at a school does not exceed the number of spaces available in a grade/program, all families who submitted a boundary exemption request form prior to the deadline shall be registered at their requested school. If the demand exceeds the number of available spaces in a grade/program, the school shall participate in a random selection procedure. This procedure provides an equal chance of registration to all students in EIPS.

EIPS encourages families to register their children at their designated school as all schools in the division offer quality educational programming. However, we recognize there are situations where families would like to register their children at a non-designated school. #### **Kindergarten Busing FAQ**

### When do I need to register my child for bus service for the fall?

You can contact Student Transportation following the Spring Break to register.

#### Is noon time busing available?

In **urban Sherwood Park** noon service is available although ride times can range from 30-90 minutes in length depending on enrollment and the pick-up or drop-off location. In **Fort Saskatchewan** noon bus service is only available to and from daycares. Day home service is not available at noon. A fee for all noon busing is applicable.

#### Is there a transfer for the noon busing? What happens at the transfer and where is it?

There is a small transfer for urban Sherwood Park noon busing behind the Sherwood Park Mall. Students board a bus at their pick-up location and may be required to board another bus that will transport them to their designated drop off location. There is a Safety Monitor at this site assisting students in locating their assigned bus.
